APPLICATION FEE

This fee is due at the time of enrollment or re-enrollment on the following schedule:

New Students	\$100
Returning Students	\$100 until March 5, 2010
Returning Students	\$125 March 6, 2010 through April 9, 2010
Returning Students	\$150 after April 9, 2010

Financial Aid applications will not be processed unless the application fee is paid in full.

MATERIALS FEE

The materials fee is \$475 and is due on June 1, 2010 payable by June 15, 2010. This fee covers textbook rental, most course materials, home athletic pass, yearbook, registration and scheduling services and development. You will receive a Materials Fee Statement in May and your 2010-2011 Tuition Coupon Book in late June.

TUITION

Note – Association churches contribute a substantial portion of the costs for their students.

You will receive a Tuition Coupon Book in late June.

You may opt to pay your tuition in full by August 18, 2010 or you may opt to pay your tuition:

By Semester: one half of your tuition will be due August 18, 2010, and January 5, 2011.

OR

Quarterly: one fourth of your tuition will be due July 1, 2010; October 1, 2010; January 1, 2011; and April 1, 2011. All quarterly payments are due on the first of each quarterly month, payable by the 15th of each quarterly month.

OR

Monthly: one eleventh of the tuition plus \$3.00 per month beginning July 1, 2010 through May 1, 2011. All monthly payments are due on the first of every month payable by the 15th of each month

Any late payments are subject to a 1% late fee. Transcripts will not be released nor may students be permitted to take semester final exams unless all accounts are current.
