"Saved to Serve" Servant Leadership Guidelines

- Every student attending Lutheran High School is required to fulfill a 20 hour community service requirement outside of their home and family environment every year in order to graduate. Any activity that meets the following guidelines is acceptable. All hours must be documented on a **Lutheran High School Servant Leadership Form**, completely and legibly, to be processed. All hours documented will be noted on the student's transcript. Completion expected by April 15 each year, except by prior approval of the Director of Campus Ministry.

Acceptable:

- Christian service/charitable service (feeding the homeless, working at a soup kitchen, caring for the elderly or someone with special needs, etc)
- Any service commencing after the successful completion of the previous school years' service date.
- Any activity completed outside of regular school hours.
- Service opportunities pre-approved by a LuHi theology teacher, parent or guardian.
- Service learning hours which receive no academic credit.
- Mission trips – domestic or international

Not Acceptable:

- **More than five hours of service learning being performed for school teams, clubs, activities, or faculty members.** (This does **not** include activities scheduled by school organizations or faculty members to assist an outside organization.)
- Any service paid for or for credit for disciplinary or judicial purposes.
- Any activity for family, friends, an employer or private business that is not approved by the theology department.
- Non-approval or absence of approval by the parent or guardian.
- Any activity completed during school hours.

Any student who has any questions regarding service should contact their theology teacher or the school office if during breaks.
