

Theater Fees for 2018-2019 school year

In order to maintain a high production value and to provide excellent opportunities for the theater students at Lutheran High, activity fees will be charged for students involved in theater. Fees will be as follows for the 2018-2019 school year:

Winter Musical Actors Fee - \$250

Spring Show Actors Fee - \$150

Winter Musical Techie Fee - \$175

Spring Show Techie Fee - \$100

Theater Fees FAQs

What are the fees for 2018-2019 and how can I pay them?

This year's Spring Show fee is \$150 and the Winter Musical fee is \$250. Fees can be paid by bringing a check to the office or to the parent meeting at the beginning of the season. Checks can be made out to Lutheran High School. Please list the student's name and the show the fee is for in the memo line (i.e. John Doe Spring Show Fee).

What is covered by the fees? Do we get anything else included with the fees?

Additional fees are required for participation in theater so that we can operate a quality program for your students. Fees cover all of the costs associated with being in a show including paying production staff, providing costumes and makeup, obtaining rights to the shows, and funding facility rental fees. In addition to show costs, students will receive a show t-shirt, snacks during production week, and their food costs will be covered for the end of the year Performing Arts Banquet. Musical participants will also have their meal costs covered the week before tech week and will get a DVD of the performance.

Will there be other fees throughout the year?

A lot of the fees that we have had to charge in the past will no longer be charged throughout the run of a show. See above for what is included in the fee. Students will still be required to provide basic elements of their costume such as cammies, undergarments, and in most cases, shoes. Also, students attending ThesCon will be required to pay in order to attend.

Are there discounts for participating in multiple shows or for siblings?

No, there are no discounts for multiple shows or siblings. In an effort to keep the overall activity fee cost low for everyone, we are not offering any discounts.

Are techies required to pay an activity fee?

Yes, these fees will cover the costs associated with the techie program including the payment of production team members working with them and costs of greater opportunities provided through the facilities in which we are privileged to work. Techies will also get the same extras including show t-shirts, snacks, etc.

How do these fees compare to other activities?

The musical fee is still \$75 cheaper than any fee associated with playing a sport at Lutheran High. As we introduce fees, we want to make sure that it is not too big of a jump as we know this could have an impact on your yearly budget. To give you another comparison, to participate in a local community musical for students in Parker costs \$400 per person.

When are fees due for each show?

Students are not allowed to rehearse until they have paid their fee. They may audition for the show but they must have their fee in before they are allowed to rehearse. If the fee is not paid by the first rehearsal, the student may be in jeopardy of losing their role.
